Active Shooter Awareness Seminar

This training covers vital information such as:

How to prepare for and respond to an act of workplace violence or an active shooter situation.

What to expect from The Pennsylvania Capitol Police during an actual active shooter incident.

Lessons learned from recent and past incidents are shared with employees. Potential scenarios and techniques for using the "run, hide or fight" options are discussed. Information on how to respond when law enforcement arrives on the scene and what current threat awareness steps can be taken to enhance your own personal safety and survival are also stressed.

Crime Prevention Seminar

In this course the Capitol Police Department offers the following vital information:

How can you improve your own personal safety in parking areas?

How should you react to suspicious people and packages in your work area?

This seminar also discusses how to trust your instincts. (Which are correct 95% of the time!)

Crimes in the workplace such as theft of property are also discussed and much, much, more!

Remember crime = desire + ability + opportunity. This seminar instructs you how to remove one of these variables out of the equation.

Both programs can be presented in approximately two hours.
